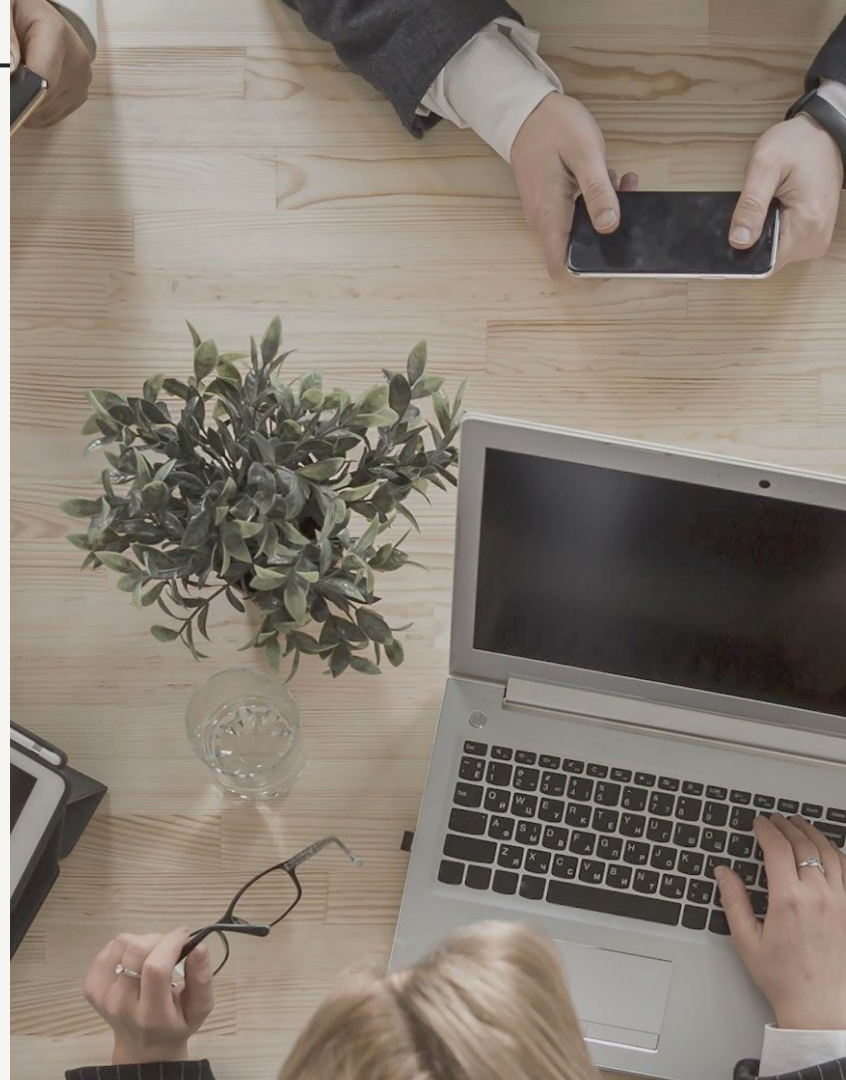

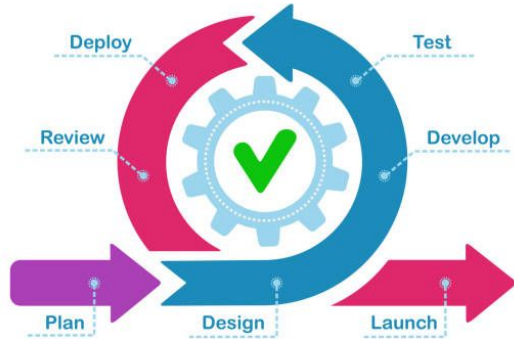
What is Agile?
